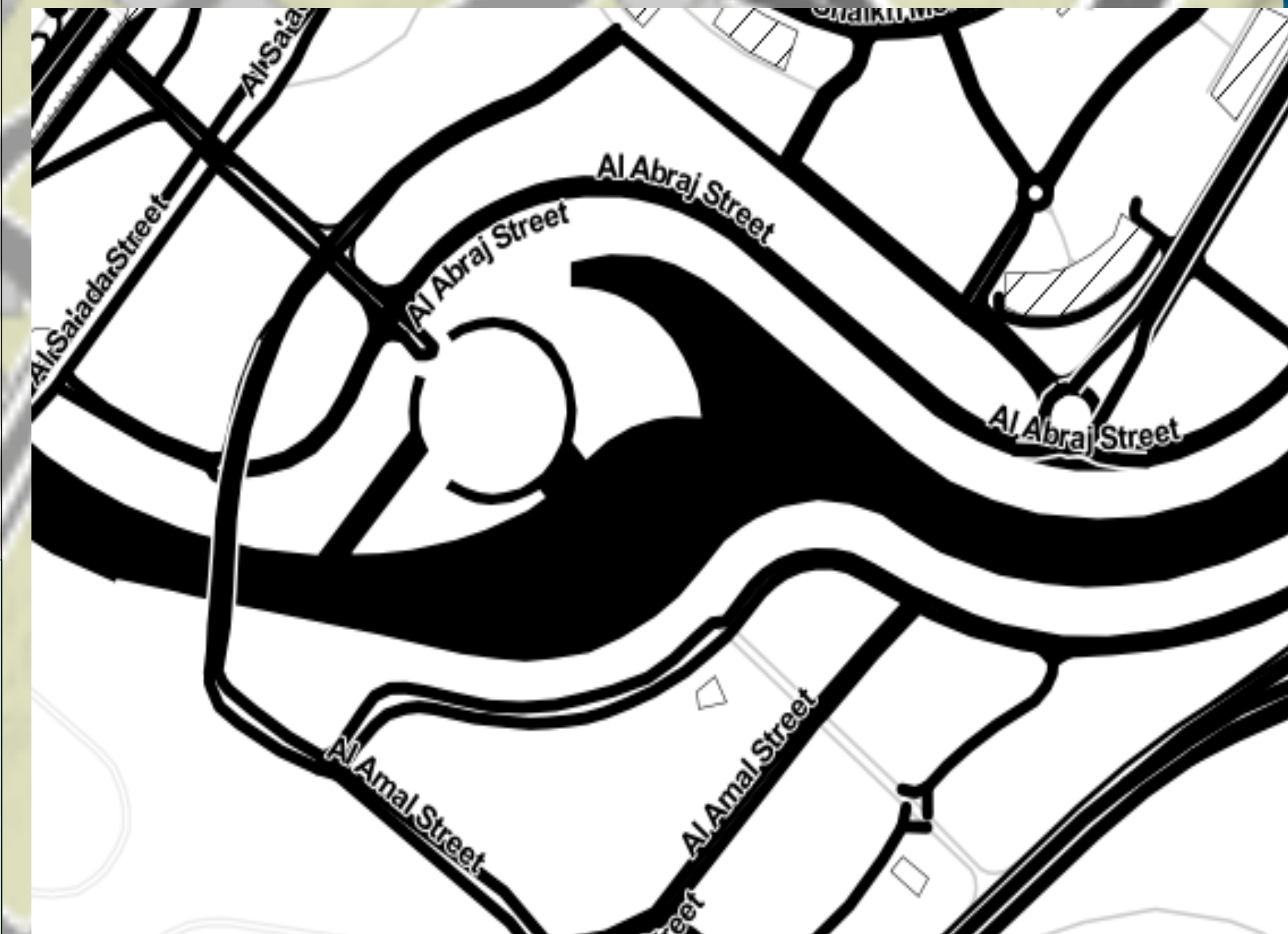
Problem #2:

Urban Park

Another identified problem in Business Bay that has the potential to be changed towards an urban park is this empty land surrounded by the stunning canal with a V-shape and is located beside the Oberai center as seen on the maps. It can consist of various design elements such as:

- Lighting
- Furniture
- Trees and Landscape

This will surely encourage public engagement and can have unique furniture for seating purposes like demonstrated below, along with different trees and to ensure that this place is given meaning by human experiences that take place within them. Urban parks are great as they help to fight pollution, encourage biodiversity in city centers and help to control temperatures and humidity. Green zones in city centers are also crucial to social cohesion along with other advantages. This seating furniture can also be a WIFI zone incase people want to come and work on their laptops or even study.

Problem #1: Bus Stop

The first project proposal is located in Business Bay and is to design bus stop's shelters as only a few areas in Dubai offer such shelters and is crucial in Business Bay due to the harsh sun during peak hours that a lot of individuals tend to wait under these bus stops which are outlined and circled in the map on the right. The function of these shelters is to act like structures designed to give protection from weather conditions such as the sun. Upon observing these bus stops I have realized that not a lot of people stand there and having a shelter like this can have a chance of increasing the number of daily riders as they will know that it won't be too hot to wait as some buses may have delays with coming precisely on time. One of the advantages of the shelter at the bus stop is that it can encourage individuals who work in the offices can start using public transportation more often, reducing pollution and making the city more sustainable. Another advantage would be that on the shelters there can be advertisements for different companies/brands that are proven effective way to advertise to drivers and pedestrians in any urban place like Business Bay.



Problem #3:

Furniture

Business Bay is one of the the main landmark for residents, I have identified a problem that there isn't a lot of lounge/seating areas especially when it is busy nowadays due to Covid regulations and the social distancing. I thought it would be a unique idea to come up with furniture that people can be enjoying sitting down or even laying down to watch the sunset for instance,It can be located as outlined on the maps above in red, around that diameter right by the Dubai Water Canal because of the different famous landmarks such as JW marriot that were outlined in my weekly diary,which concludes why I went for this specific area. They make it clear that people are welcome and that the street is a pleasant place to be. These facilities both have a practical purpose for the visitor and provide visual appeal and detail. We all get tired and search for a spot to relax from time to time, and in those cases, these pieces of street furniture serve as our oasis. Problem #4

Public bookcase
The last design element in Business Bay that I decided to go for which is a public bookcase due to an issue that I have personally seen and heard that there is almost no public engagement takes place in the area with very basic public furniture and to provide a suitable solution to this I believe it would be a great idea to provide multiple bookshelves that can be either fixed at a lamp post as sketched below so if pedestrians decide to stop by and grab a book to read they could do so. A public bookcase is a cabinet that may be freely and anonymously used for the exchange and storage of books without the formalities associated with libraries. This idea was highly inspired by my research on my previous case study in Beirut. Another spot within the area would be the urban park located as displayed below on the maps and similar concept to the lamp posts bookshelves they can be in a form of a box for it to not just have a function of encountering visitors to come by, but also as a design element at the park. Public bookcases are quickly and universally enjoyed if they are centrally located, easily accessible, and filled with sufficient content.
